

ACCESS STATEMENT

Disabilities

Putt Above welcomes visits by guests with disabilities. We will do everything
possible to ensure a safe environment during your visit, however, the game does
involve some mental and minor physical tasks. We always advise guests contact
us before hand to ensure we can make the very most of your visit with us.

Discrimination

• We have the right to refuse participation to Putt Above should we feel there is danger to a person for whatever reason. The Health & Safety Executive state that for these reasons no discrimination is evident.

Sign Points

• This guide has been compiled to ensure you get the most out of your experience with us. Please observe the safety information available on the website. It is the guests' responsibility to obey these instructions, before taking part in the activity.

Around the Site

• All of Putt Above is based on 1 level with wheelchair accessible doorways. The width of all doorways are at least 72cm with the inclusion of the accessible toilet.

Transferring

• Transferring from a wheelchair is the guest's and helper's responsibility. Our team are not permitted to assist the transferring of guests at any time. The team will give full instructions for the activity.

First Aid

• Our sites may have limited First Aiders, however communication will be available to contact the emergency services should they be required.

Medications

• We cannot store or keep any medications. We also recommend that you do not participate if you are taking any medication. This must be disclosed to the games host before participation.

Car Parking

• Directly outside Putt Above is a carpark. This car park is free for 5 hours and has ramps that lead up to the entrance of the venue.

Toilets

• We have one fully accessible toilet that meets all current building regulations.

Game Specifics

• In some games, flashing lights are used to create atmosphere. The venue has low levels of light due to the projection nature of the games.

Putt Above Specifics

- At least 1 member of your team must be able to stand to ensure games can be completed.
- There is some physical aspect of the game as each shot/dart/puck must by physically hit, thrown.
- If in any doubt, guests should contact Putt Above before bookings.

Putt Above Specifics (Assisted Club)

- Putt Above has a specially designed club that allows guests to hit the ball from a seated position, this removed the need for players to stand and take a shot and are not required to get up onto the platform.
- There is some physical aspect of the game as each shot must by physically hit up the ramp.
- The club works using wheels that allow the club to glide forward, this enables the ball to be hit from a seated position.
